Greenville in Harmony Chorus draws its **80+ female members** from across the Upstate and parts of North Carolina, including Greenville, Spartanburg, Anderson, Pickens, Oconee, and Gaston counties.

Greenville in Harmony Chorus has performed in locations across the Upstate, including: Fluor Field, the Red Cross' "Affair with Flair," the Biltmore Estate, Artisphere, "She" (formerly the Upstate Women's Show), Greenville Chautauqua, local retirement communities, nursing homes, and veterans' organizations.

Greenville in Harmony Chorus competes annually in regional competition, having recently achieved 1st Place **Regional Champion** in 2014.

Greenville in Harmony Chorus is affiliated with **Sweet Adelines International**, an organization promoting the American art form of barbershop harmony through education and performance with more than 25,000 members worldwide.

Greenville in Harmony Chorus is **directed by Nancy Field** who is also a coach, international certified judge, and the Education Coordinator for the five-state Heart of the Blue Ridge Region.

Greenville in Harmony Chorus produces an **Annual Show** in late fall which has been sold out for two years in a row.

Greenville in Harmony Chorus sponsors "**Sing for Scholarships**," an annual talent contest for high school-age students which provides the winners with scholarship awards.
